The general aim of this course is to review your Greek reading and comprehension skills and to expose you to a variety of texts in Greek. The specific goal of the course this semester is to read the Gospel of Matthew. We will note the peculiarities of the Koine dialect while reviewing Attic Greek.

Class will meet about 50 minutes two times per week. During this time we will translate, discuss, and interpret the readings. You are expected to come prepared to every class. Preparation means review of the reading from last class and work on the reading for the next class.

Your course grade will be based upon your **daily class performance** and upon an **ORAL final examination**. You can request a verbal evaluation of your performance at any time during the term. In general, you will be graded in this course based upon the "3 P's" of **PREPARATION**, **PARTICIPATION**, and **PROGRESS**.
