The course will include guided visits to: Roman Forum, Palatine Hill, the Colosseum, Capitoline Museums, St. Peter's Basilica and Square (including a possible Papal audience), Vatican Museum (including the Sistine Chapel) Pantheon, Piazza Navona, Trevi Fountain, Museo Nazionale Romano, Villa Giulia, Centrale Montemartini, Ostia Antica outside Rome, and a day trip to Pompeii and to the National Museum in Naples.
