Ancient Rome: From Romulus to Justinian

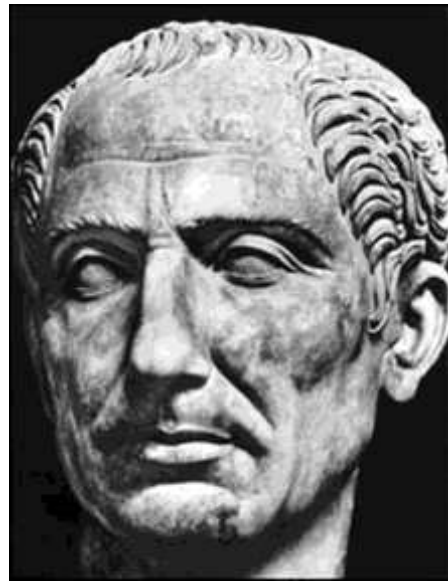
