### Section 1: Livy

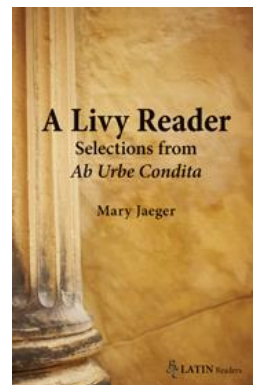
In this course we will read excerpts from Livy's *Ab Urbe Condita*.

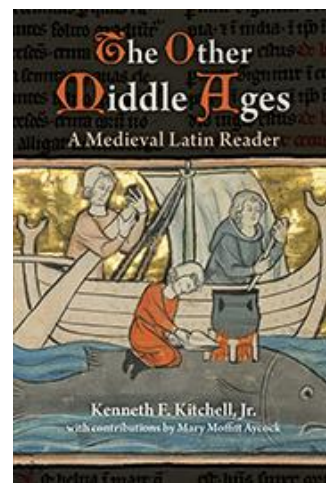
### Section 2: Medieval Latin
