

In many ways, THE BACCHAE asks a lot of audiences. There is a lot of background material we are no longer familiar with, the style of presentation is far less realistic than we are used to, and we're asked to sit for more than an hour without an intermission...

Euripides' contemporaries would have been far more accepting of the "justice" of Pentheus' fate, and probably more willing to be "lectured to" than most of us. So, why this production, for us, now?

One reason is this is one of the ancillary texts used by ILA this fall. We are pleased that several ILA sections will attend the show, and we will meet with them to discuss it. We also believe that it is important for audiences to see a wide variety of genres and forms; and so we try to do an ancient Greek piece at least every four years.
