Courses are listed in the earliest semester in which it is recommended that they be taken. In most cases, the courses may be taken in a later semester without serious consequence. See the notes below for recommendations related to individual courses. The following courses are required: Math 106, Business 105, 211, 212, 218, 305, 306, 307, Business 405/406, Economics 200, 300/301, and four 300+ level course offerings from business administration, economics, or accounting.

Helpful Tips:

BUSI 105 should be taken in the 1st or 2nd semester. In most cases, this should be the first course in the program.

MATH 106 should be taken in the 2nd or 3rd semester.

BUSI 211 and 212 should be taken in the 2nd, 3rd or 4th semester. Normally, BUSI 211 and 212 are taken after MATH 106.

ECON 200 should be taken in the 2nd or 3rd semester.

Normally, ACCT 203 is taken in the sophomore year (3rd or 4th semester).

BUSI 218 should be taken during the sophomore year (3rd or 4th semester).

BUSI 305 should be taken as soon as possible after BUSI 105 and ECON 200 (3rd, 4th, 5th or 6th semester).

BUSI 307 should be taken after BUSI 105 and ECON 200.

BUSI 306 should be taken in the junior year or 7th semester.

ECON 300/301 should be taken in the 5^{th} , 6^{th} or 7^{th} semester.

Electives may be chosen from 300+ level course offerings in business administration, economics, and accounting.

The capstone course BUSI 405/406 should be taken in the 7th or 8th semester. The core courses at the 300 level (ECON 301, BUSI 305, 306 or 307) are prerequisites for the capstone.
