COURSE ACTIVITIES

This course is required each semester for all declared Theatre majors. It is also a participation course which counts toward the Beauty and Meaning in Works of Art General Education Requirement. It has a course credit of .25 and can be repeated up to 8 times. The general activities for this course are 1)having an acting role in a major production, 2)-serving as a director or designer of a major production, 3)-serving on a stage crew of a major production, 4)completing 30 hours in a theatre shop. Each student is responsible for arranging an individual course of study at the beginning of each semester
